

According to the Grant Agreement for NeuronAgeScreen-GA737599, we have posted the advertisement for two (2) MSc Studentship positions in life sciences at the Tavernarakis laboratory. The text for the programme open position posts has been published on October 20, 2017 at the website of the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology-FORTH (P.N.  $10224/20-10-2017 - ADA: \Omega6\Phi X469HKY-\Theta\Delta P$ ) and the website of the Institute: (http://www.imbb.forth.gr/jobs/201017 Tavernarakis.pdf).

The desired qualifications of the applicants involved Bachelor degree in Biology/related fields and prior documented experience on nematode genetics and fluency in English.

Each applicant has submitted their application as complete .pdf files to the Lab Manager in charge i.e. Angeliki Pasparaki in response to the advertised position (Ref # ORZ-0055) who archived all the applications. The number of applications that have been received is six (6).

Dr. Nektarios Tavernarakis, Dr. Vasiliki Nikoletopoulou and Dr. Maria Markaki are the aforementioned scientists in charge on behalf of FORTH that consist the evaluation committee for the selection of the postdoctoral scientist. The committee convened on November 3, 2017 and evaluated the six (6) applications that have been selected for the open call regarding the positions offered in the laboratory of Professor Nektarios Tavernarakis. After careful examination of all applications the committee decided to make an offer to the following applicants: Ms. Evridiki Asimaki and Mr. Emmanuel Chaniotakis. The selection was made on the basis of the education background of the applicants, their prior expertise and relevance in terms of their prior scientific focus to the MANNA's program aims.

All the applicants have been accordingly informed about the outcome of the evaluation process and Ms. E. Asimaki and Mr. E. Chaniotakis were invited to sign a contract with IMBB-FORTH.
