The text for the NEUROPHAGY's open positions posts has been published on December 12, 2016 at the website of the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology-FORTH (http://www.imbb.forth.gr/jobs/121216_Nikoletopoulou_ORZ-0028.pdf). The desired qualifications of the applicants included an MSc degree in Life sciences, fluency in English, and experience with biochemical assays and mouse models.

Dr. Nikoletopoulou, Dr. George Garinis, Dr. Kosteas are the aforementioned scientists in charge on behalf of FORTH that consist the evaluation committee for the selection of the postdoctoral scientist. The committee convened on January 9th and evaluated the eleven (11) applications that have been selected for the open call regarding the position offered in the laboratory of Professor Vassiliki Nikoletopoulou. After careful examination of all applications and the interview with selected candidates the committee decided to make an offer to the applicant Theodora Chalatsi. The selection was made on the basis of the education background of the applicant, their prior expertise and relevance in terms of their prior scientific focus to the program aims of NEUROPHAGY.

All the applicants have been accordingly informed about the outcome of the evaluation process and Theodora Cha
