We are seeking a Project Manager for the H2020 Marie Skłodowska Curie European Training Network Chromatin3D coordinated by the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology at the Foundation for Research and Technology (the Coordinator) in Heraklion, Crete.

Chromatin3D is a joint training network of 12 consortium members (academic & non-academic) and 4 partner organisations that will recruit and train 15 early stage researchers.

The duties for the Project Manager include the management and coordination of all activities and communications between the coordinator, the partners and the early stage researchers of the network, the organization of network meetings, scientific workshops and other training activities, of dissemination activities, the monitoring and implementation of reporting requirements and the overall support of the coordinator in his duties.

A prerequisite for the successful candidate is relevant experience in managing European training networks, as well as fluency in English and excellent organization, communication and interpersonal skills.
