The Governing Board of IMBB approved the election of two new Group Leaders in IMBB.

Dr Constantine Stratakis (Elected Researcher A'), Former Scientific Director of the National Institute of Child Health, NIH will join IMBB to establish a lab investigating signaling pathways and genetic defects involved in the pathophysiology of endocrine tumors. His research focusing on translation of molecular and genetic discoveries to better diagnosis and treatment of pediatric disease will further strengthen IMBBs efforts to develop excellence in the translational research area. Dr Stratakis will also help networking IMBB with Greek pharmaceutical company.

Dr. Evgenia Ntini (Elected Researcher B') is currently a senior Post-Doctoral Fellow in Max-Planck Institute for Molecular Genetics in Berlin. Dr Ntini's past and current research interest is on mechanistic aspects of long non-coding RNAs in transcription regulation. Her research also focuses on modeling chromatin dissociation of lncRNAs using nascent RNA sequencing data and machine learning algorithms.
